Pre-Qualification Requirement:

The prospective bidder should be either a single bidder or on a joint venture/consortium/partnership firm basis formed by maximum two members. To qualify, bidder should have fulfilled the following minimum qualifying requirements:

1. The bidder should have successfully executed the work of coal transportation through Road-cum-Rail(RCR) mode from CIL subsidiaries i.e., the work of coal lifting and transportation of coal by road from mines as well as experience in liaison with Railways/CIL subsidiaries i.e., arranging rakes, dispatches coal from own or leased Private siding or Goods shed Rly. siding by loading of coal into railway wagons through own arrangement with monitoring the rake movement etc. up to the destination Power house. The bidder should have executed such works as above for State Owned Power Generating Companies / Other Power Utilities/ NTPC/ Govt./ Semi Govt./ IPP/ PSUs in India.
2. The bidder should have executed total quantity of coal not less than 1.75 Lakh Metric Tonnes with atleast single order of 1.0 Lakh Metric Tonnes executed in one month during last 7 years ending with original bid opening date.
3. The work execution certificate by the customers alongwith self attested un-priced copies of aforesaid work order(s) should be submitted.
4. The bidder shall submit the following documents
 - (a) Self attested copy of valid EPF registration certificate.
 - (b) Self attested copy of valid GST Registration certificate.
5. Financial Qualification: -
 - a) Average annual turnover of the firm for the last three financial years (ending March'18) shall not be less than Rs. 19.66 Crore.
 - b) The net worth for the last financial year should be positive.
 - c) Turnover and Net worth certificate for the above issued by a practicing Chartered Accountant shall be considered. Audited Profit & Loss Account, Audited Balance Sheet should be submitted. Other income like from sale of fixed assets/property indicated in the statement of Profit and Loss Account of bidder shall not be considered for turnover purpose.
 - d) In case where audited results for the last financial year as on the date of submission of bid are not available, the financial results certified by a practicing Chartered Accountant shall be considered acceptable. In case, Bidder is not able to submit the certificate from practicing Chartered Accountant certifying its financial parameters, the audited results of three consecutive financial years preceding the last financial years shall be considered for evaluating the financial parameters.
6. Other Essential Requirement to be fulfilled by all Bidders:-
 - (i) An affidavit (on non judicial stamp value Rs-100/-) to the effect that the bidder is not declared black listed /debarred for participation in tender by State Owned Power Generating Companies/ Other Power Utilities/ NTPC/ Govt./ Semi Govt./ Any Leading Industries/ IPP/ PSUs anywhere in India on the date of submission of tender.(As per Annexure-XI of tender document)


- (ii) The bidder is required to give an undertaking in the form of an affidavit (on non judicial stamp value Rs-100/-) to deploy equipments/ tippers/ Pay loaders commensurate with the ordered quantity.
7. Bidding through Joint Venture/Consortium/Partnership firm basis formed by maximum two members:-
- (i) Joint Venture/Consortium/Partnership firm should meet out the whole Pre-qualifying criteria either by one partner or jointly. A notarized copy of registered partnership deed/Consortium agreement/Joint deed of undertaking in this regard should be submitted.
- (ii) The Leader of the consortium shall be authorized in charge and his authorization shall be evidenced by submitting duly notarized Power of Attorney in Rs. 1000/- Stamp paper signed by legally authorized signatory of each of the members.
- (iii) In case a partner is common in two partnership firms, such offer(s) shall be summarily rejected.
8. Duly filled Annexure 1(A),(B),II,III,IV,X,XI of tender shall be submitted alongwith PQR document.
9. Important Instructions:
- (i) Bidders/JVC/ Consortium are not permitted to seek Financial/Technical Qualification on the credentials of their Parent/Associate companies.
- (ii) Bidding through Joint Venture/Consortium/Partnership firm is permitted subject to fulfilling conditions as detailed in the tender document.
- (iii) One bidder/one firm/ Joint Venture Company/Consortium/ Partnership firm can submit only one bid. The multiple bids submitted by sister concern/subsidiary/parent company are liable to be rejected.
- (iv) The offers received without pre requisite credentials /PQR documents, shall be summarily rejected. Decision of MPPGCL in this respect shall be final.
- (v) Notwithstanding anything stated above, MPPGCL reserves the right to assess the creditability, capability and capacity to perform the contract. Should the circumstances warrant such an assessment in its overall interest, bidder shall furnish additional documents to substantiate its claim. MPPGCL also reserves the right to seek such additional information as it may deem fit to satisfy itself of the eligibility of the bidder.
- (vi) Canvassing i.e. soliciting favor, seeking advantage etc. in any form is strictly prohibited and any bidder found to have engaged in canvassing shall be liable to have his bid rejected summarily.
- (vii) If the bidder deliberately gives any wrong information in his tender to create circumstances for the acceptance of his bid, MPPGCL reserves the right to reject such tender and to take action for banning for the business with MPPGCL.
